- •Reduce transmission of HIV

Couple's/ Men's/Women's Behaviors

(Behavioral Outcomes)

- Access community legal, medical and psychosocial resources aimed at the prevention, support or response to IPV
- Access informal sources of support (e.g., family members, communities of faith)
- Maintain personal boundaries
- Negotiate and resolve conflict in a non-violent way
- Incorporate gender-equitable behavior into personal, social and community life
- Respect partners personal boundaries
- Resist/speak out against gender inequality, including violence, and promote gender equitable norms
- Provide support to women experiencing IPV
- •Get tested and/or treated for HIV and other STIs
- Discuss HIV risk behavior with partner under safe circumstances and take prevention measures as appropriate (i.e., getting tested, using condoms, reducing partners)
- Reduce number of extramarital partners
- •Increase use of condoms with extra-marital partners
